Option 2: Hosted Exchange

- Total Outlook integration
- Calendar, Contacts, Tasks
- Works w/iPhone, better w/Android



Data Wherever & Whenever You Need It



- Dropbox, Apple iCloud, Microsoft Skydrive, a few others
- ALL work in similar fashion
 - Transparent desktop/laptop sync
 - Mobile App and integration
- On computers, data is sync'd to the "Cloud" automatically
- On mobile, limited auto-sync plus on demand data access



